Grant Application Guidelines

The Women's Foundation of Oklahoma is pleased to make available grant awards up to \$5,000 each in support of services for single mother students offered by a public institution of higher education.

All public college and university campus recruitment/advisement offices that work with non-traditional programs for students who are single mothers are encouraged to apply. The Women's Foundation of Oklahoma Grant is to be used to further assist efforts toward recruitment, enrollment, and retention of single mothers pursuing a degree and/or career certification at public higher education institutions. This grant making initiative focuses on providing systemic support for single mother students on campuses across Oklahoma.

Applications are available online at www.wfok.org with submission deadline of May 2, 2019, for project implementation June 15, 2019 through May 30, 2020. A final evaluation report with statistical data will be required as well as attendance at the convening of grant recipients.

Grant applications should be focused on one or more of the following program strategies:

- Expanding awareness of educational opportunities for single mother students on your campus
- Creating new and/or supporting existing programs for single mother students on your campus
- Creating new and/or supporting existing events for single mother students

The Women's Foundation of Oklahoma invests in economic self-sufficiency for Oklahoma women & girls and is specifically interested in advancing educational opportunities for single mother students. As an endowed fund of the Communities Foundation of Oklahoma, the Women's Foundation of Oklahoma derives its grant making budget from the annual distribution of the endowment as well as through the additional support of foundation and individual donors.
