The Women's Foundation of Oklahoma (WFO) is pleased to make available **Grant Awards up to \$5,000 each** in support of a public higher education institution's services for single mother students. The WFO Grant is to be used to further assist your efforts toward recruitment, enrollment, and retention of single mothers pursuing a degree and/or career certification at your institution.

This is the fourth year of this grant making initiative which focuses on providing systemic support for single mother students on campuses across Oklahoma. As an endowed fund of Communities Foundation of Oklahoma, WFO derives its grant making budget from the annual distribution of the endowment as well as through the additional support of foundation and individual donors.

All public college and university campus recruitment/advisement offices that work with non-traditional programs for students who are single mothers are encouraged to apply. Applications are available online at www.wfok.org with submission deadline of January 19, 2018, for project implementation June 1, 2018 through May 30, 2019. A final evaluation report with statistical data will be required as well as a convening of grant recipients.

Grant Information: The Women's Foundation of Oklahoma (WFO) invests in economic self-sufficiency for Oklahoma women & girls and is specifically interested in advancing educational opportunities for Single Mother Students. Grant applications should be focused on one or more of the following program strategies:

- Expanding awareness of educational opportunities for Single Mother Students
- Creating new and/or supporting existing programs on campuses
- Creating new and/or existing events for Single Mother Students

Grant Timeline:

- Technical assistance Zoom meeting: Thursday, December 14, 2017
- Application Deadline: Friday, January 19, 2018
- Notice of Grant Awards: On or before April 13, 2018
- Term of Grant Implementation: June 1, 2018 through May 30, 2019 (one full academic year)
- Final Evaluation Report with Statistics: June 3, 2019
- Required Grant Representative(s) Convening: September 12, 2019
